Rapid Response Vehicle 4X4 (RRV), General Information

The vehicle is based on an ISUZU chassis and manufactured by Pick Up Systems Ltd.

Cumbria Fire and Rescue Services Rapid Response Vehicles (RRVs) are located in areas of the county where sufficient local support and additional weight of attack is available from other appliances and crews as reflected in CFRS Risk Based Evidence Profile (RBEP). We currently have RRV's based at Arnside, Staveley and Maryport.

The RRV has an appliance inventory that reflects the requirements of a rapid response at an incident and also to make scene safe until additional resources are in attendance.

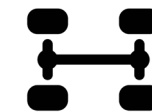
