Wildfire Unimog 4X4, General Information

The Wildfire Pods were manufactured by Angloco (UK) Ltd, and mounted on a Unimog U500 Chassis. The cab has seating for 2 crew members.

Cumbria Fire & Rescue Service has 2 Wildfire Units which can be mounted onto CCC Unimog vehicles at seasonal times throughout the year (April to September) when not being used as a snow clearing unit/gritter by the Highways Department.

These are located at Whitehaven & Appleby Fire Stations, with the off road capability to reach otherwise inaccessible areas, these vehicles bring an added dimension to the fleet when tackling wildfires in and out of the county.
