historic paper HSFV forms are placed in the confidential waste bins. This change ensures compliance with Data Protection law; specifically the data minimisation principle.

Radio messages to Fire Control are an important part of the incident command system. Messages allow decisions to be recorded on the incident log, allow SM, GM and AMs to gain situational awareness (especially regarding the hazards involved), make decisions regarding cover moves, and share information with other agencies.

You can find up-to-date guidance on the four types of radio messages here.




