PDR Pro Course Reminder

Learning and development are still nominated individuals on PDR for refresher courses such as Incident Command, Breathing Apparatus and other critical skills.

Every individual can see when they are nominated on courses.

For risk critical skills this is on the skill dashboard (please see below).

For non-risk critical skills this in the outstanding CMS nomination tab.



If you are unable to make the course you have been nominated for, please contact the **FireserviceLD@cumbriafire.gov.uk** inbox to rebook on a different date.

All dates are published on the course calendar. This is in the CMS tab of PDR Pro.

It is the individual's responsibility to make sure your risk critical skill is up to date.

No extensions are given to these skills and individuals will be taken off the run if refreshers are not completed in time.

If you would like notifications to go to different email addresses, please change the email address.

You can do this by:

- Hovering over your name at the top right of PDR Pro
- Click my account
- Click change security details
- Change your email and click submit

This will only change your notification email on PDR Pro and not your username or password unless you change this too.

All managers are notified when their reports are booked onto courses by the system as well.

Managers are responsible for making sure that the correct people report to them on PDR Pro.

This can be done through the personnel managed tab.
