

M6 J36–J39 overnight closures in September

Personnel please be aware that the service has been informed by Kier Transportation Highways that the **M6 J36 to J39 north and southbound** carriageways will be closed overnight from **Monday 1 September to Wednesday 10 September 2025** between **8pm to 5am** as follows:

- Northbound closures will begin on **Monday 1 September** for approximately **six nights**
- Southbound closures will begin on **Monday 8 September** for approximately **two nights**

However, please note, we have been informed by Kier that there will still be access for blue light services during these closures.

Access onto the motorway at junctions 36, 37 and 38 will be possible to travel with caution through Kier's work area.

North and southbound diversion

You'll be diverted between junctions 36 and 39 by Kendal using the A6, A591 and A590.

Ongoing traffic management

The hard shoulder and lane one on the northbound carriageway will remain closed between Borrowbeck and Castle Howe (just after junction 37 towards junction 38).

There will also be a localised hard shoulder and lane one closure at High Gill – this is where traffic management starts on the northbound carriageway.

On the southbound carriageway, the hard shoulder and lane one on the carriageway will also remain closed between Castle Howe and Borrowbeck (just after junction 38 towards junction 37).

On both carriageways two lanes will remain open to traffic for the foreseeable future and junction 38 will still be accessible.
